

Tux Cross-Stitch Pattern v1.0

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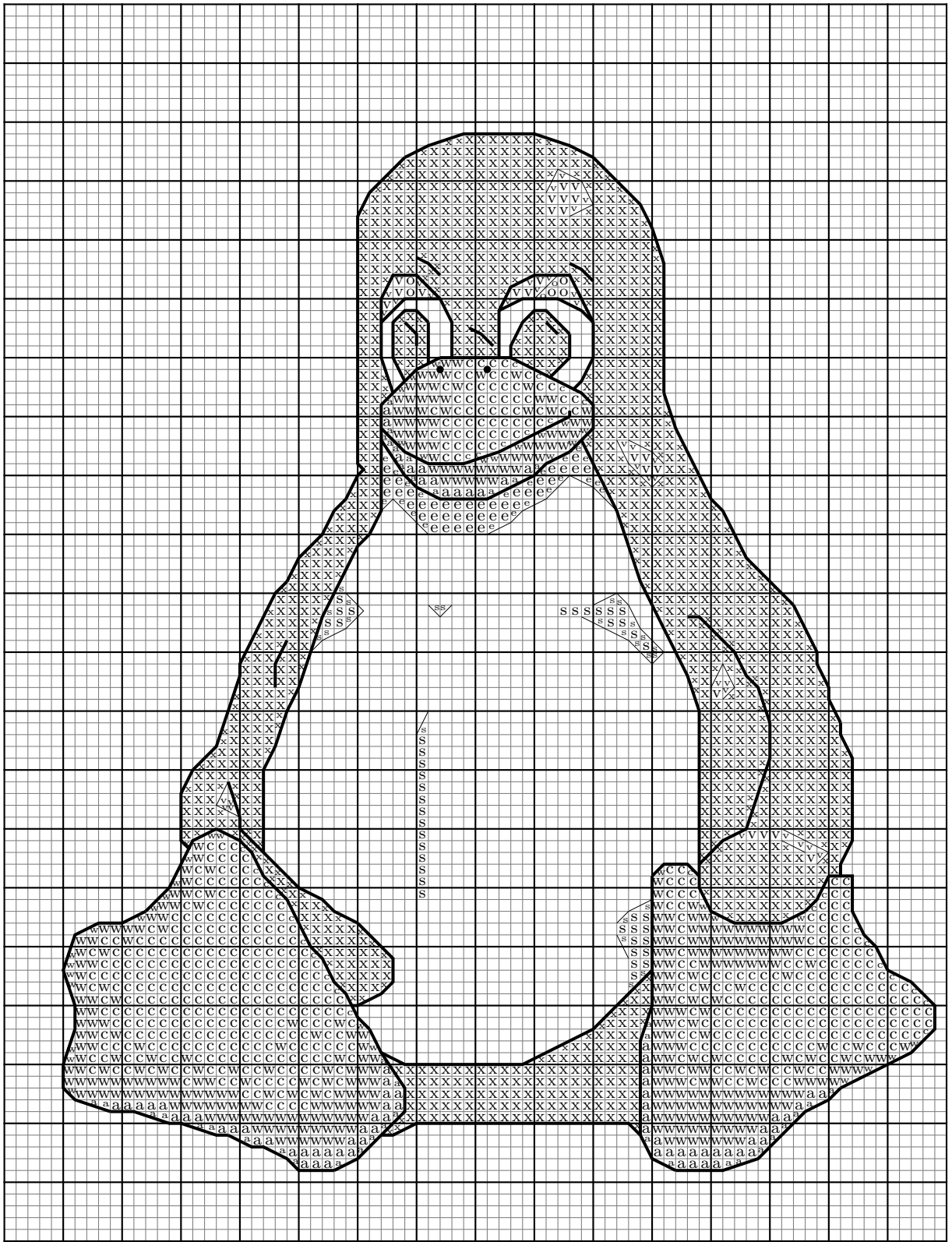

Backstitch	301	Mahogany Medium

1. First complete all cross stitch, using 2 threads of floss. Empty squares in the eyes and stomach are stitched with White.
2. Backstitch the outside of the body (against the white fabric) using 2 strands of 310.
3. Backstitch the accent lines on the body using 2 strands of 414.
4. Backstitch the beak and feet using 1 strand of 301.
5. Backstitch the eyelids using 1 strand of 414.
6. Backstitch the interior outlines of the body (eyes and stomach) using 1 strand of 310.
7. Make french knots (●) on beak using 2 strands of 301.

The sample was stitched on 28 count white linen (2 over 2). The design stitch count measures 74 x 88. The finished design area measures $4\frac{3}{8}$ " x $6\frac{3}{8}$ ".
